

O'Brien-Staley Partners brings on 2 to build impact investing team

Matthew Reilein and Carleen Rhodes were hired by O'Brien-Staley Partners to build a fixed-income impact investment team.

Mr. Reilein is managing director and portfolio manager, and Ms. Rhodes is special adviser to the credit manager's new impact investing strategy, which is targeted to manage \$500 million, said Bruce Weintraub, an OSP spokesman, in an e-mail.

Mr. Reilein was a Chicago-based managing director in community development banking for J.P. Morgan Chase. Ms. Rhodes retired in May as CEO of Minnesota Philanthropy Partners, a network of Minnesota-based non-profit organizations with aggregate assets of \$1.2 billion. She was replaced by Eric Jolly in July.

OSP manages \$490 million for 20 institutional investors, Mr. Weintraub said.
